- We will support you to develop a project.
- You get money for your project.
- If you feel unsure about corona-related issues, we're here to give advice.

What exactly is a “project”?

The options are endless! Here are some ideas: workshops, performances, poetry slams, meetings with other young people, sports events, internet blogs, and whatever you’re able to dream up!

A project might only take one day, last for a few hours, or take place regularly over the next year. You can invite people to come listen to or watch your project... or you can invite someone who inspires you (e.g. musicians, specialists, role models) to come speak or perform for you. It is important that your project is completed by November 30, 2022 at the latest.

Once you come up with an idea for a project, you have until January 26, 2022 to apply!

Since TAKT is funded by the federal government, the funding for this program is pending approval by the Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth (BMFSFJ).
