TAKT is brought to life by the activities of everyone who wishes to participate in the project.

TAKT as a “local partnership for democracy” is funded by the Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth through the program “**Live Democracy!**”. The program supports associations, projects and initiatives in many German cities which promote democracy and diversity, and prevent extremism.

Here you will find information on how to apply for financial support for your project idea:

Who decides which projects will be funded?	<p>In 2022, a total of € 35,000 is available to support project plans.</p> <p>A TAKT-jury proposes individual projects to be funded. The jury is elected by TAKT-council. The council in turn is composed of committed members of groups, associations and institutions based in Tübingen, of members of the municipality and of local politicians. At least half the members of TAKT-council are members of marginalized communities.</p>
Which topics are eligible for funding?	<p>Funding is available for any ideas and projects which fight discrimination and promote an open-minded and diverse Tübingen and a safe life for everyone.</p> <p>In 2022 we fund projects with a focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● racism, anti-Semitism, anti-Muslim racism, denigration of Sinti and Roma people, ...● prevention of extremism● L(esbian), G(ay), B(i), T(rans), I(nter), Q(ueer)● gender identity, gender diversity or sexual orientation● culture of democratic coexistence in diversity <p>The project should pertain to at least one of these topics. Additionally, the following topics can be addressed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● other forms of group-focused enmity: discrimination based on body, disability, class/social background, age, ...● multiple discrimination / intersectionality

<p>Which activities can be funded?</p>	<p>Different kinds of activities can be funded, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● public events (panel discussions, performances, lectures, ...) ● empowerment (group meetings, events, ...) ● workshops (open to a specific group or the general public) ● PR work (Instagram, blogs, films, posters, ...) ● media and arts projects (films, writing, exhibitions, ...) ● dialogue and networking (meetings, round-table discussions, ...)
<p>Where can the projects take place?</p>	<p>Each project's focus needs to be on the town of Tübingen. This means that the intended audience of the project either lives or works in Tübingen or is involved in the town in other ways.</p>
<p>How much money can you apply for?</p>	<p>Individual projects can be subsidized with up to €5,000. Funds are granted for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● costs for fees, e.g. for coordination, guest speakers, childcare, or interpreters ● material costs, e.g. for flyers, rent, board, work materials etc.
<p>When can projects begin, and when do they have to be completed?</p>	<p>You can begin your project directly after receiving grant approval (expected by April 2022).</p> <p>Projects must be completed by November 30, 2022.</p>
<p>Who can apply for funding?</p>	<p>Only nonprofit associations and nongovernmental institutions can apply.</p>
<p>What to do if you have a project idea but aren't a member of any association?</p>	<p>We will support you to find an association to apply jointly with you.</p>
<p>What is the application deadline?</p>	<p>Applications should be submitted by January 26. The jury decides in mid-February.</p> <p>If you come up with a project idea after the deadline, please don't hesitate to contact us. We will clarify whether funding is still possible.</p>
<p>Where and how can you apply?</p>	<p>Application form, finance plan and important information concerning the application can be found on our website at www.takt.online.</p> <p>Please send the application form along with a financial plan for your project via e-mail or by post to adis e.V., Fürststr. 3, 72072 Tübingen or TAKT@adis-ev.de by January 26, 2022.</p>
