Then TAKT is the right place for you. Here you can design a project! Your wishes and ideas are important!

Perhaps you would like to work on a topic in a closed group. Or you can imagine sharing your experiences in Tübingen with other young people through art, rap, texts and pictures. You don't need any previous experience.

- We will work with you to decide which project suits your ideas.
- We can help you find an association that can become your project sponsor.
- We can help you write the project proposal.
- We can help you design the project.

The great thing is that you get money for your project!

And what is a "project"?

Here are some ideas for projects: Workshops, concerts, poetry slams, meetings for young people, sports events, internet blogs, and much more.

A project is a one-time action with a specific goal. To achieve the goal, actions must be planned and implemented. The project has a beginning and an end. It must be clearly differentiated from existing offers.

It can be just one day, last for a few hours or be a regular offer. You can invite other people and tell them something. But you can also invite other people (e.g. musicians, experts, role models...) and let them tell you something.

It is important that your project is completed by 30.11.2024 at the latest.

How and until when can you apply?

You can apply with your project idea until January 29, 2024. You will need an association to submit the application with you. The application form must be completed and signed.

A jury of young people decides which projects can be supported.
